PeridotX Health Care is a complete, web-based clinic and corporate medical-center management system. It replaces paper registers and disconnected spreadsheets with one connected workflow — from the moment a patient checks in at the dispensary, through doctor diagnosis and prescription, to the pharmacy counter that dispenses the medicine — while keeping every department's data in one place and every action on record.

Whether you run a single company clinic, a multi-branch corporate health center, or a panel-hospital referral network, PeridotX gives your staff a fast, guided screen for every step, and gives management the reporting to see the whole operation at a glance.

How a Visit Flows Through the System

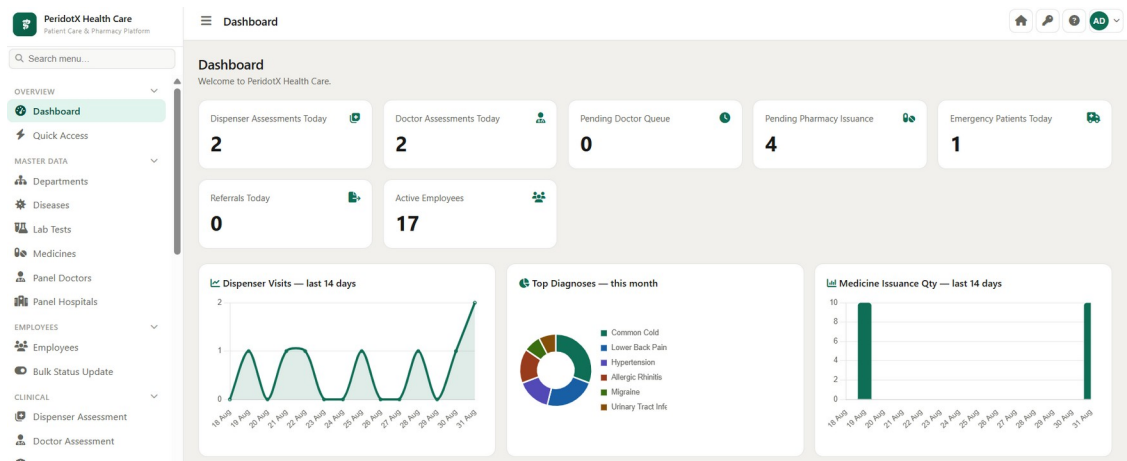
Reception → Dispenser Triage → Doctor Assessment → Pharmacy Issuance

with Referrals to panel hospitals and an Emergency intake path available at any point

1. Reception & Registration Look up an employee or dependent in seconds, or register a new visitor, before they're ever seen.	2. Dispenser Triage Vitals — blood pressure, pulse, temperature, sugar, weight — and chief complaint, captured on one clean screen.
3. Doctor Assessment Diagnosis, prescription, lab orders, and referral decisions, with the patient's full history one click away.	4. Pharmacy Issuance A pending queue the pharmacist works from, with batch/expiry tracking and a recheck workflow for corrections.

See Everything, the Moment You Log In

Every role opens to a live dashboard built around what that person actually does — an administrator sees the full clinical and pharmacy picture with trend charts, while doctors, dispensers, pharmacists, and reception staff each get a more vibrant, focused view scoped to their own queue and their own numbers. Nobody has to go looking for what matters to them.



The administrator dashboard — today's queue counts, a 14-day visit trend, top diagnoses, and pharmacy issuance volume.

Clinical Care, Handled Safely

- **Structured vitals & chief complaint** — blood pressure, pulse, temperature, blood sugar, and weight captured as real data, not free text, so trends and reports actually work.
- **Allergy & risk-flag awareness** — patient allergies and high-risk / chronic-condition notes surface right on the assessment screen, before a prescription is written.
- **Pregnancy-risk medicine warnings** — medicines flagged as pregnancy-risk carry a visible note wherever they're prescribed or dispensed.
- **Lab test ordering & results** — order a lab test from the assessment screen and record the result against it once it's back.
- **Referrals with a real audit trail** — refer to a panel hospital or doctor, print the referral once, and issue a tracked “correction” referral instead of silently editing a printed one.
- **Emergency intake** — a dedicated fast-entry path for walk-in emergencies, linkable to a known employee or dependent when one is recognized.
- **Doctor reassignment** — move a waiting patient to a different doctor without losing their place in the queue.

Pharmacy & Inventory, Under Control

- **Prescribe-to-dispense workflow** — a clean pending queue the pharmacist works from, so nothing prescribed is forgotten.
- **Batch & expiry tracking** — every medicine batch carries its own batch number and expiry date, tracked down to what was actually issued.
- **Low-stock alerts** — a configurable threshold per medicine, with a dedicated Low Stock report so re-ordering happens before you run out.
- **Recheck flow** — a documented way to correct an issuance after the fact, rather than editing history.
- **Medicine rates & master list** — a maintained price list and medicine catalog shared across prescribing, dispensing, and reporting.

Every report respects the same permission model as the rest of the app, and every export is audit-logged.
